



A lot of action and mayhem at the Cornwall Motor Speedway!

Cornwall, Ont – Sunday, September 13, 2009 – Martin Bélanger – The Cornwall Motor Speedway presented his annual Fireball Enduro Race sponsored by Headline Auto Parts. A full afternoon of racing action with 50 laps feature race for 4 cylinders for women, two 50 laps for 4 cylinders men, 50 laps 6 cylinders and 50 laps for the 8 cylinders. It is not called the WWE of racing for nothing.

The afternoon started with the 50 laps 4-cylinder women, 39 ladies registered. After 30 minutes of racing, Crystal Allard was the first to complete all the laps to win the feature race.

The men's 6-cylinder were next on the track with 101 cars scheduled to start the 50-lap feature race, a few rollovers combined with a lot of accidents all around the track that caused a few red flags. After 55 minutes of racing mayhem, François Lascelle was the first driver to cross the line.

The first of 2 features for the 4-cylinders took the track with a 50-lap race. A total of 70 car took the track for the first finale. After the race was done, only about a dozen cars were running, the big winner was Stephan Gerstgrasser of Casselman.

More horsepower hit the track with the 50-lap 8 cylinder feature race with 55 cars taking the initial green. Pro-Stock driver, Ghyslain Valade dominated the race by doing consistent laps and finished with nearly a 2-lap lead over the second place car.

The night ended with the second 50-lap 4-cylinder feature race, a field of 80 cars started the feature, just like the other ones, about a dozen of cars left on the surface at the end. Bruno Richard made a last lap move to pass Pro-Stock regular Marc Lalonde for the win.

Over 345 cars got registered with the biggest crowd of the season attending. All the races finished with about a quarter of the starting cars.

Next week is the season ending event with a special 50-lap Quebec-Ontario Showdown for Sportsman. The Pro-Stocks will also be in action along with 25-lap event for Semi-Pro and Mini-Stocks, both categories will crown their 2009 champions. A big demolition derby will end the afternoon. The first heat is scheduled to start at 2pm. A great way to end the season with the Terminator !
