With 15 or more karts in the Jr Sportsman 2 class they had to make 2

separate feature events. In the first feature it was the 4 of young Jasmin David who took the lead early on and never looked back taking her into victory lane once again. In the second feature it was the 1 of Justin Lallancette who took the checker flag and puts yet another feature win under his belt.

The box stock seen the 15x of Shane Pecore work his way from the back to the front giving him his first feature win at Cornwall Karting Club in 2008. Shane is a multi talented driver who runs the regular Stock Car Sportsman class regularly in Brockville and has won a feature race at Edelweiss Speedway a couple weeks back.
