



High expectations for 2009 at Cornwall Motor Speedway

Cornwall, On – Monday, April 27, 2009 – Martin Bélanger – With around 3 weeks left before the opening of the 2009 season, the Cornwall Motor Speedway held the annual meeting over the weekend to discuss on different subjects in order to get the staff ready for a big summer!

A lot of important shows have added to this year's schedule, the season starts strong on Sunday, May 17 with the first race of the Lucas Oil Canadian DIRT Challenge, a 100-lap finale for 358-modifieds in which the winner will get a nice \$3,000, more than 40 modifieds are expected for opening night.

After 3 weeks of regular nights racing excitement, a Loonie-Toonie night has been added. On Sunday, June 14, it will only cost fans 2\$ to get in and see a regular show! It is only at Cornwall Motor Speedway that you will see this type of promotion! It will be the cheapest night of racing in the east in 09!

The Triple Crown of Racing is back this year on Sunday, June 21, but a with a new flavour, the very spectacular World of Outlaws Late Models are back along with the mighty 358-modifieds and a new category, the SpeedSTR, a kind of midget sprint car, a great field of cars is expected in all classes. More than \$75,000 in purse will be given out during that memorable evening. The Green Mamba Jet Car along with 25-lap feature for Semi-Pro and Mini-Stock (formally known as Rookie Stock) will close the month of June on the 28th on Summer Sizzler Night.

A huge month of July awaits fans with 4 shows, on July 5th, the MrDIRT sportsman trail will make a stop to Cornwall after a long absence, all the stars of that series should be in the pits for this 50-lap feature. The Mohawk Race Parts Pro-Stock Series is also on tap during that night with also a 50-lap event.

The following week, the big-blocks will be in town for the Akwesasne Mohawk Casino International 100, the Advance Auto Parts Super DIRT Series Stars will be at the track for the 100-lap modified event. This show usually attracts a big field of cars and also a lot of fans in the stands. The sprint fans will be pleased on July 19 with the Patriot Sprint Group making their first visit at the quarter mile bullring, these winged warriors will give a show to remember to the fans. A complete race program will end the month of July.

A lot of action will occur in August with 5 nights of racing. The final race of the Lucas Oil Canadian DIRT Challenge will start the month on August 2nd with a 100-lap double points feature race with the winner getting a cool \$5,000 for his win. On the following Sunday, it will be the Race for Children Fundraiser night with a complete race program.

The Late Model fans will have a second treat with the Ontario DIRT Late Model Series making their first appearance at the track on August 16th for a 50-lap feature race. This series runs under the same rules as the World of Outlaws. On the subsequent Sunday, the MrDIRT Pro-Stock series will make a haul to Cornwall with a 50-lap feature race. A roofless modified feature along with a complete race program will finish August.

The popular Jiffy 150 will kick off September on Sunday the 6th with the 358-modified MrDIRTcar series race, 100 laps of small block racing action along with the last race of the Mohawk Race Parts Pro-Stock Series. To end the 2009 season, two afternoon shows are on the plate with the annual Fireball Enduro Race on the 13th and the Terminator with the Quebec-Ontario Sportsman 50-lap Showdown.
