



Boisvert, Ladouceur, Philipps and Tyo winners on Loonie-Toonie Night at Cornwall Motor Speedway

Cornwall, Ont – Sunday, June 14, 2009 – Martin Bélanger – What can you get for 2\$ in 2009? Well at Cornwall Motor Speedway you got a full racing program for that amount in general admission on On Tap Sports Bar & Grill Night! All the categories had some action.

Joel Doiron took the early lead in the 30-lap modified feature with Perry Francis and Marc Therrien in second and third. The first five laps went quickly and Doiron built himself a comfortable lead over Francis. Roy Delormier brought the first caution on lap 8. Doiron got too high on the restart and Francis became the new leader with Alain Boisvert now in second and Doiron in third. Laurent Ladouceur was now challenging Therrien for the fourth spot and Carey Terrance was also in the mix at the halfway point. Francis and Boisvert were doing battle for the lead as Boisvert used the inside lane to pass Francis on lap 17. The leaders were now in traffic with less than 10 laps to go. Doiron was able to pass Francis in these conditions on lap 23. With 5 laps to go, Boisvert had a full stretch lead over Doiron. Marc Therrien spun out in the front stretch and Brian McDonald hit him hard on lap 28 and caution came out. Boisvert was able to lead the final 2 laps to win his first feature of the season over Doiron, Francis, Terrance and Ladouceur rounded out the top 5. Joel Doiron, Lance Willix and Carey Terrance won the heat races in

In the 20-lap Pro-Stock feature, Ricky Thompson got a good start and took the early lead over Corey Wheeler and Ghyslain Valade, Daniel Leduc got out the track in turn and caution came out on lap 2. Thompson stayed first as caution came out for Dion Oakes who is having some problems. Thompson is still the leader as a lot of battles were going on in the back for positions with 5 laps in the books. Mike Gaucher spins in turn 2 and yellow is out on lap 6. Thompson retained the lead with Valade now in second as Joey Ladouceur was strong on the inside lane and took third spot on lap 8. Louie Jackson stopped on the backstretch and yellow is out on lap 12. Valade had good start and took the lead with Ladouceur taking second as yellow came back out on lap 14. Valade managed to stay first but had company with Ladouceur as Gaucher spun out in turn 2 with 4 laps to go. Valade used the outside lane with Ladouceur still with him and Aubin following them closely as Steve Johnston spun out with only 2 laps to go. Ladouceur made a good move in the final turn and was able to beat Valade at the flagstand, Aubin finish third, Thompson and Pete Stefanski completed the top 3. Ricky Thompson, Ghyslain Valade and George Renaud were the winners in the qualifiers.

Kevin Jodoin took the early lead in the 15-lap Semi-Pro feature with Guy Regimbald in second as Kevin Fetterly Jr did a rollover in turn 1 on the first lap and red came out.

Jodoin stayed first first as Sébastien Bazinet lost control in the backstretch as caution came out on lap 3. Jodoin kept the lead with Vandette now second after pushing Regimbald. Cryderman stopped and caution came out on lap 7. Vandette is penalized five spot for rough riding on Régimbald. Robert Delormier had a great start as he passed Jodoin for the lead, Jodoin had problems and this brought the yellow on at the halfway point. Delormier had a strong start with Jean-Paul Laberge and Jeff Philipps following him. Philipps passed Laberge and used the outside lane to pass Delormier for the lead with only 3 laps to go. Philipps led the final laps to win the feature over Laberge and Nathan Delormier completed the podium. Philipps had a perfect night winning the second heat, Jodoin and Regimbald won the others.

In the 12-lap mini-stock feature, Chris James took the early lead but goes high in turn one and Frank Belair was the new leader as the first caution came out on lap 2. On the restart, Belair kept the lead but Ronnie Tyo passed him on the following lap, Belair who was the leader a lap ago landed on the roof in the backstretch and red came out on lap 4. Gerry Oszczakiewicz had a good start and took the lead with Jean-Marc Larose and Guillaume Daoust passing Tyo, Chris James brought the yellow on lap 7 with Larose the new leader. When the green lights came back on, Larose had Tyo and Oszczakiewicz on his back, Tyo used the inside lane to pass Larose on lap 9. Tyo led the final laps to win the feature over Larose and Mark Radbourne completed the top 3. Tyo had a perfect has we won the 3rd heat, Corey Winters and Jean-Marc Larose won the others.

The biggest event of the year is already knocking at our doors, as the second edition of the Triple Crown of Racing will be presented next Sunday. The World of Outlaws Late Model will be at the speedway. These drivers gave a show to be remembered last year and will do the same this year. Come and see the Steve Francis, Darrell Lanigan, Josh Richards, Shane Clanton, Rick Eckert, Tim Fuller, Chub Frank and many more of the best drivers on DIRT.
