



Ladouceur, Jackson, Philipps and Larose winners on Summer Sizzler Night at Cornwall Motor Speedway!

Cornwall, Ont – Sunday, June 28, 2009 – Martin Bélanger – With July at the doorstep, Cornwall Motor Speedway presented Summer Sizzler Night with the presence of Doug Rose and the Green Mamba Jet Car who burned a car down at the end of the show along with a complete race program with 25-lap features for Semi-Pro and Mini-Stock categories on Pennzoil and Jiffy Auto Night.

In the 30-lap modified feature, Roy Delormier took the early lead with Ron Valade and Tim O'Brien in the top 3; Delormier had already a good lead when Perry Francis brought the first caution on lap 4. Delormier kept the lead with Laurent Ladouceur taking third, as Joel Doiron lost a wheel on his car and the field slowed down with 7 laps in the book. Delormier still the leader but had Ladouceur on his tail at the restart with Carey Terrance now third. Ladouceur passed Delormier on lap 9 to become the new leader as Boisvert did the same thing on Terrance for third. Delormier bobbled and Boisvert took second on lap 14. At the halfway point, Ladouceur was the leader with Boisvert, Terrance, Delormier and O'Brien your top 5. Ladouceur was working in traffic as the point's leader Kayle Robidoux slowed in the backstretch and caused the third caution with only 9 laps to go. Ladouceur was still the leader with Boisvert in second at the restart; Mitch Jock cracked the top 5 with 5 laps to go in the feature. Boisvert was closing in on Ladouceur while Jock took third on Terrance on lap 27. Ladouceur was able to resist on Boisvert to win the feature, Jock completed the podium with Terrance and Delormier rounded out the top 5. Kayle Robidoux, Alain Boisvert and Yan Bussière won the heat races. Gage Morin rolled hard in the first heat his car had heavy damage.

Michel Desjardins was the early leader with Ricky Thompson second in the 20-lap Pro-Stock Feature while Louie Jackson was strong from the inside lane in third with 5 laps completed as Thompson got the lead. Joey Ladouceur stopped in turn and caution was out on lap 7. Thompson had a strong start with Jackson second with David Papineau now third as William Chubb hit the wall in turn 4 and caution came out on lap 9. Louie Jackson took the lead on the restart over Thompson with Papineau still in third. With 5 laps to go, Jackson had a good lead over Thompson with a 3-car battle going on for third when Ladouceur and Ghyslain Valade got together in turn 2 and yellow is back out on lap 18. Jackson was able to resist at late charges of Thompson to capture the feature over Thompson and Corey Wheeler completed the podium. Jackson and Papineau had won the heat races.

In a special 25-lap Semi-Pro feature race, Kevin Fetterly took the lead with Guy Régimbald in second when caution came out on the first lap. Fetterly still the leader with Joe Woods and Brent Kelsey second and third as a great battle was going on in the top 5

with 6 laps in the book. Fetterly got into traffic as Yves Vandette got issues with his car on lap 9. Fetterly had company with Kelsey on the restart, as Sébastien Bazinet and Kevin Clement got together and Clement went on the roof and the red flag came out on lap 11. Kelsey got the lead using the inside lane on the green, with Robert Delormier now in third. Kelsey and Fetterly had good fight for the lead when Fetterly had issues with the car and yellow came with 7 laps to go. Kelsey had a new dancing partner with Jeff Philipps doing battle for the lead with 20 in the books. Philipps used the outside lane to grab the lead on lap 22. Philipps managed to stay in front to win his second feature of the season in front of Kelsey and Derek Cryderman completed the podium. Kevin Fetterly and Guy Regimbald had won the qualifiers

Gerry Oszczakiewicz got the lead in the 25-lap Mini-Stock Feature as Carl Gorry slowed and caution came out on the first lap. Oszczakiewicz stays first with Jean-Marc Larose was racing hard and took second when yellow came back on lap 4. Oszczakiewicz and Larose got a good battle and Larose was the new leader when race slowed again on lap 5. Oszczakiewicz and Larose were swapping the lead as Oszczakiewicz regained the lead on lap 7 and started to pull away with Benoit Laroche taking third on lap 9. Cory Winters who was running in the top 5 had issues with his car and yellow was back out on lap 11. Oszczakiewicz and Larose pulled away from the rest of the field with Laroche still third. Oszczakiewicz had issues and Larose got back the lead on lap 17. Larose was still in front with Ronnie Tyo now second as hed passed Laroche with Marc Usereau having problems on the front stretch and yellow got back on the field with 5 laps to go. Larose resisted to the charges of Tyo to win the feature, Laroche completed the podium. Gerry Oszczakiewicz and Ronnie Tyo were the winners in the qualifiers.

Doug Rose and the Green Mamba Jet Car completely burned a car at the end of the show putting a spectacular show for the the fans.

A big show next week at Cornwall with the MrDIRTcar Sportsman trail with a huge field of the best sportsman drivers expected at the track. A 50-lap feature race is on the schedule for this class that only makes rare appearances at the speedway. The third race of the Mohawk Race Parts Pro-Stock Series is also on the schedule with a 50-lap event for them. The Modifieds and Mini-Stock will also see some action. Be there for this great show!
